



Driving Directions

From the North: About 2.5 miles from the bridge turn left at the first traffic light onto Md. Route 235 South. Travel 10.6 miles through Lexington Park and past the Patuxent Naval Air Station. Turn right onto Mattapaney Road and continue 1.9 miles to the College on right.

From Washington, D.C. and Northern Virginia via the Capital Beltway:

Take the Capital Beltway (I-495/95) to Exit 11A for Md. Route 4 South. Follow Rte. 4 for about 54 miles through Prince Frederick and cross the Thomas Johnson Bridge at Solomons, crossing into St. Mary's County. Follow detailed directions "from the north" in italics above.

From Annapolis:

Take Route 2 South. Continue on Route 2/4 through Calvert County to Solomons. Follow detailed directions "from the north" in italics above.

From Baltimore:

Take I-97 South to Route 301 South (Exit 7). Take Route 301 to Route 4 South in Upper Marlboro. Go south on Route 4 for 54 miles to Solomons. Follow detailed directions "from the north" in italics above.

From Richmond:

Take I-95 North to Route 207. Go toward Bowling Green, where Route 207 joins Route 301. Continue on Route 301 North across the Potomac River Bridge. Continue on Route 301 for about 10 minutes. Turn right at the traffic light onto Route 234. Turn right onto Route 5 South. Go through Leonardtown and continue on Route 5 for 20 minutes to the College. You have reached the college when you see the St. Mary's River on your right.

From Southeast Virginia (e.g., Norfolk, Virginia Beach):

Take I-64 West to Route 17 North (J. Clyde Morris Blvd.). From Hampton, continue 100 miles to Route 301 North. Travel on Route 301 across the Potomac River Bridge. Continue on Route 301 North across the Potomac River Bridge. Continue on Route 301 for about 10 minutes. Turn right at the traffic light onto Route 234. Turn right onto Route 5 South. Go through Leonardtown and continue on Route 5 for 20 minutes to the College. You have reached the college when you see the St. Mary's River on your right.

******Warning about Online Map Services******
