**A RESOLUTION CONCERNING
THE TREATMENT AND PUNISHMENT FOR
THOSE INDIVIDUALS INVOLVED IN SCHOOL VIOLENCE**

40 WHEREAS: School shootings are on the rise all over the country; and

50 WHEREAS: Schools are supposed to be safe for all children to attend
60 without fear of death or injury; and

70 WHEREAS: Some try to sympathize with the offenders, who seem to
80 have troubled lives and relationships; and

90 WHEREAS: Lives are ruined and institutions are destroyed by the
100 actions of such offenders.

100 THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: There shall be a mandatory sentencing law concerning school
110 shootings; and

120 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That all involved in school shootings shall be tried as
130 adults, provided that they are over the age of reason; and

140 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That all involved in school shootings shall receive the
150 maximum punishment allowable by law, not to
160 exceed however life imprisonment without the
170 possibility of parole.
