40     **WHEREAS:**     Following the loss to Duke University of Maryland students rioted across  
50                     the city of College Park, setting bonfires, toppling cars, and destroying property;

70     **WHEREAS:**     It has been estimated that damage to city public property is in the  
80                     vicinity of \$35,000; and,

90     **WHEREAS:**     Damages received to cable wiring is estimated to be between \$250,000 and  
100                    \$500,000; and,

110    **WHEREAS:**     It is unacceptable for anybody to cause this kind of destruction, and the fact that  
120                    most students were drunk makes it even more irresponsible; and,

130    **WHEREAS:**     Rioting such as this brings bad publicity and attention to a state funded  
140                    institution, and brings down the level of integrity of a highly reputable school.

150    **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:** That the Maryland Student Legislature condemns the actions  
160                    of University of Maryland students following the loss to Duke on March 31<sup>st</sup>,  
170                    2001.
