10 AN ACT CONCERNING

20 **Transportation - Tolls - Exemptions**

30 FOR the purpose of exempting active duty military personnel, EMT or firefighter from any
40 vehicular crossing in which a fixed toll is paid.

50 BY AMENDING

100 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE MARYLAND STUDENT LEGISLATURE That the Laws of
110 Maryland read as follows:

120 **Article – Transportation 21-1413.**

130 (a) A person may not fail or refuse to pay the prescribed toll at any highway or
140 vehicular crossing for which the payment of a toll is fixed, EXCEPT FOR ACTIVE MEMBERS OF
150 THE U.S. MILITARY.

160 (b) A person may not attempt to evade the payment of the toll at any highway or
170 vehicular crossing for which the payment of a toll is fixed. THE AFOREMENTIONED ACTIVE
180 MILITARY PERSONNEL MUST PRESENT VALID MILITARY ID FOR EXEMPTION FROM
190 TOLLS. THE EXEMPTION DOES NOT APPLY WHEN PERSONS NOT IN THE MILITARY ARE IN
200 THE VEHICLE.

210 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect January 1, 2002.
