20 **Vehicle laws- Removal of Drivers Education**

30 FOR the purpose of altering the requirements to obtain a drivers license;  
40 and requiring the learners permit period to be extended to one year.

50 BY repealing and adding to

70 Section 16- 105(d)  
80 Annotated code of Maryland

90 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE MARYLAND LEGISLATURE,  
100 that the laws of Maryland reads as follows:

110 **Article-Transportation**

120 § 16-105

130 (d) (1) An individual who holds a learners instructional permit may not take a drivers  
140 skill examination or driver road examination for a provisional license:

150 (i) Sooner than ~~4 months~~ ONE YEAR  
160 1. After the date on which the individual first obtains the learners  
170 instructional permit.

180 (2b) ~~Minimum student performance standards for approved driver education~~  
190 ~~program consisting of at least 30 hours of classroom instruction and at least 6~~  
200 ~~hours of highway driving instruction.~~
