30 WHEREAS: Tens of thousands of innocent motorists on highways across the country have
40 been victims of racial profiling; and,

50 WHEREAS: African Americans, Hispanic and members of other minority groups are being victimized
60 daily by law enforcement agents who were sworn to protect them; and,

70 WHEREAS: African Americans are pulled over and searched far more than whites in Maryland even
80 though this state is being federally monitored.

90 THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Maryland Student Legislature praises all jurisdictions that
100 have already voluntarily collected statistical data on traffic stops and searches; and,

110 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That Maryland requires local law enforcement
120 agencies to collect statistical racial data on traffic stops and searches.
