10 A RESOLUTION CONCERNING  
20 THE UNITED NATIONS AND ITS INVOLVMENT IN POST-WAR IRAQ

30 WHEREAS: The United Nations refused to back up the U.S. at the start of Operation: Iraqi  
40 Freedom; and,

50 WHEREAS: The main component of the coalition in Iraq has been the United States and  
60 should be the ones who are in charge of rebuilding the nation of Iraq; and,

70 WHEREAS: The commitment of our President and government officials has shown that we  
80 plan to be there until the job is done; and,

90 WHEREAS: The French, German, and Russian delegations in the UN made it extremely  
100 difficult to work out a compromise in the beginning of the conflict, and therefore  
110 should not be considered for a position in rebuilding the country; and,

120 WHEREAS: The United States has an outstanding plan in place to rebuild the country with  
130 help from Iraqis inside and out of the embattled nation; and,

140 WHEREAS: The United Kingdom, and its Prime Minister Tony Blair, along with other  
150 coalition countries have been the only active ally of the Americans, and  
160 therefore deserve to have the privilege as the additional help we will need in re-  
170 organizing the Iraqi government; and,

180 WHEREAS: Some Americans found it insulting that the French, Germans, and Russians  
190 would continually refuse to help assist us in the freeing of the Iraqi people.

200 THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED : That the Maryland Student Legislature urges the executives in  
210 charge of rebuilding the Iraqi government to not let the United Nations,  
220 including the French, German, or Russian delegations, to take part in the  
230 reconstruction effort; and,

240 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Maryland Student Legislature thanks and commends  
250 the President and Prime Minister Blair for their dedication to this freedom effort  
260 and that Congress and the British Parliament agree to fund the effort until the  
270 final goals are achieved.
