100 SECTION 1: BE IT ENACTED BY THE MARYLAND STUDENT LEGISLATURE, that the laws of Maryland
110 read as follows:

140 (a) *Definitions-*

150 (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

160 (2) “restroom” means any establishment that:

170 (i) Has more than one urinal; and,

180 (ii) Is not located in a private residence.

190 (b) *In General* – Dividers shall be placed on both sides of urinals in restroom facility. Dividers shall meet the
200 following requirements: placed at level with the urinal, no less than eight inches on each side of the urinal, no less
210 than one half inch thick, extending no less than two feet from the wall, and no less than three feet tall.

220 (c) *Applicability* – The provisions of this section shall apply to all new construction after of January 1, 2005, or
230 buildings for which a building permit is issued after January 1, 2006

240 SECTION 2: AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this act will take effect January 1, 2005.
