10 **A RESOLUTION CONCERNING LEGALIZATION OF ASSISTED SUICIDE**
20 **FOR THE TERMINALLY ILL.**

30 **WHEREAS:** The patients who are greatly ill and have a deadline on their life and/or have so
40 much pain due to their condition who would prefer to die over living in so much
50 horror ask their doctors to assist them in suicide; and,

60 **WHEREAS:** Such doctors who have in the past assisted such patients have been convicted
70 and found guilty of a murder even though the patient gave them complete
80 consent.

90 **THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED:** The Maryland Student Legislature recommends the
100 Maryland Congress to make assisted suicide legal as long as the patient is
110 qualified and is willing.
