10     **A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE SAFETY AND SECURITY OF THE UNITED**  
20     **STATES**

30     **WHEREAS:**     In excess of one million people enter the United States illegally per year over the  
40                     border between the United States and Mexico.

50     **WHEREAS:**     There has been alarming increase in terror related activity in the south western  
60                     United States, known Al-Qaeda members have attempted to enter the United  
70                     using human smuggling rings and assuming the appearance of other Hispanic  
80                     immigrants.

90     **WHEREAS:**     Due to the fact that there are terrorists, narco terrorists, and gangs such as MS-13  
100                    operating in the southwestern United States, sheriffs from bordering counties  
110                    have stated that they would feel safer taking trips to Baghdad.

120    **WHEREAS:**     There is such a level of lawlessness in Laredo, Texas, businesses are shutting  
130                    down,     tourism centers are closing down and the general population is

290                    wall after one hundred and fifty yard intervals, with floodlights and mounted
