10 **A RESOLUTION CONCERNING TUITION RATES FOR UNDOCUMENTED**
20 **IMMIGRANTS**

30 **WHEREAS:** Various states have enacted legislation, which allow for in-state tuition for
40 undocumented immigrants able to provide proof of residence; and,

50 **WHEREAS:** Maryland restricts access to higher education by denying access to in-state
60 tuition to undocumented immigrants; and,

70 **WHEREAS:** Beginning October 1, 1994 the Maryland General Assembly, increased

80 **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:** That the Maryland Student Legislature recommends
90 that the Maryland General Assembly pass and the Governor sign legislation allowing
100 undocumented residents access to the same in-state tuition rates available to all other
