40     **WHEREAS:**     William Donald Schaefer served the State of Maryland as an  
50                     elected official for 50 years, and

60     **WHEREAS:**     Schaefer served on the Baltimore City Council, four terms as  
70                     Mayor of Baltimore, two terms as Governor of Maryland, and two  
80                     terms as Comptroller of Maryland, and

90     **WHEREAS:**     Schaefer's legacy includes the construction of Oriole Park at  
100                    Camden Yards, stricter environmental protection measures to  
110                    preserve the Chesapeake Bay, and increased standards for public  
120                    schools, and,

130    **WHEREAS:**     The significant contributions of William Donald Schaefer to the  
140                    State of Maryland deserve recognition, and,

150    **WHEREAS:**     The State of Maryland traditionally names highways in honor of  
160                    influential political figures, such as the Dwight D Eisenhower  
170                    Highway, the John F Kennedy Memorial Highway, and the  
180                    Theodore McKeldin Highway.

190    **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:** That the Maryland Student Legislature  
200                    urges the Maryland General Assembly to name Interstate 97  
210                    "William Donald Schaefer Highway."
