80 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE MARYLAND STUDENT

90 LEGISLATURE, That the laws of Maryland read as follows:

100 § 10-501 Criminal Law

110 (a) A person may not commit adultery.

120 (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on

130 conviction shall be fined ~~\$10~~ NO MORE THAN \$50,000.
