10 **RESOLUTION CONCERNING CLOSED COURSE EXAMINATION FOR DRIVERS**

20 **WHEREAS:** Maryland's examination does not require an applicant to drive anywhere
30 outside the examination courses; and,

40 **WHEREAS:** There is absolutely no traffic on such courses; and,

50 **WHEREAS:** Driving on such courses merely tests the applicants ability to maneuver
60 the car at slow speeds; and,

70 **WHEREAS:** The above shows little to none of how well an applicant is able to drive a
80 vehicle on the city streets and highways.

90 **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:** That the MVA should incorporate on-road
100 examination instead of closed course in order to be sure of an applicant's ability to
110 handle a vehicle in factual driving circumstances.
