20 **THE CONSTITUTIONALITY OF SPEED CAMERAS**

30 **WHEREAS:** Under current Maryland Law, a registered owner of a vehicle caught exceeding
40 the speed limit by a traffic enforcement camera is fined automatically via mail;
50 and,

60 **WHEREAS:** Speed cameras violate Article 21 of the Maryland Declaration of Rights, as well
 amendments 4, 5, 6 and 14 of the United States Constitution.

70 **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:** The Maryland Student Legislature urges the state of
 Maryland to repeal House Bill 443, as well as disable and remove all operational
 speed cameras.
