150 by the lowest bidder and would therefore stimulates another country's economy  
160 and not ours; and,

170 **WHEREAS:** These are only two of the vast amounts of pork that were put into this bill to buy  
180 off votes, which also grants tax cuts to people who have not paid taxes, spends  
190 almost a trillion dollars to buy cars for the federal government and is overall  
200 wasteful, instead of saving the economy it adds one trillion dollars of debt to an  
210 already large debt and instead of helping the economy, will cause increased  
220 inflation as the value of the dollar tries to increase as the recession comes to an  
230 end.

240 **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:** That the Maryland Student Legislature urges the United  
250 States Congress not to craft nor pass, and the President not to sign, any more  
260 stimulus packages so as to not further risk the long term prosperity of the
