10 **A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE PROTECTION OF THE UNITED STATES OF**  
20 **AMERICA FROM ECO TERRORISM**

30 **WHEREAS:** The wildfires that have ravaged Australia in the month of February have killed,  
40 thus far, at least 200 people and caused hundreds of billions of dollars in
