**10 A RESOLUTION CONCERNING MARYLAND CITIZEN PROTECTION**

20 **WHEREAS:** A great proportion of crime happens at night; and,

30 **WHEREAS:** People are unable to protect themselves when they are unable to see; and,

40 **WHEREAS:** People are weak creatures in need of being protected; and,

50 **WHEREAS:** Governments are instituted among men to protect them from themselves; and,

60 **WHEREAS:** Anyone who votes against this bill opposes the safety of Maryland citizens, and is with some  
70 likelihood a terrorist;

80 **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:** That a curfew for all Maryland citizens should be instituted,  
90 disallowing any Maryland citizen from going outside after 10:30 or before dawn, unless he shall  
100 have a clearance certificate granted by the Governor O'Malley or a security council selected by  
110 Governor O'Malley;

120 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:** That citizens should be permitted to stay out until 11:00 on Fridays and  
130 Saturdays only, unless they shall have one of the aforementioned clearance certificates;

140 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:** That, in order to enforce this new, patriotic curfew, cameras should be  
150 placed all throughout Maryland to monitor human behaviour and the police of Maryland shall  
160 be instructed to shoot to kill any citizen or non-citizen caught disobeying the curfew;

170 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:** That anyone caught opposing or dissenting on the vital necessity of this new  
180 Maryland citizen protection policy shall be treated as an enemy of Maryland people, and shall  
190 be taken into custody by whatever means necessary.
