60 Title - 22. Vehicle Laws – Equipment of Vehicles.

70 § 22-201.1. When lighted lamps are required.

80 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

90 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

100 Article – Transportation

110 § 22-201.1. When lighted lamps are required.

120 Every vehicle on a highway in this State, at ALL TIMES ~~any time when, due to insufficient light~~
130 ~~or unfavorable atmospheric conditions, persons and vehicles on the highway are not clearly~~
140 ~~discernible at a distance of 1,000 feet ahead~~, shall display lighted lamps and illuminating devices
150 as respectively required in this subtitle for different classes of vehicles, subject to exceptions with
160 respect to parked vehicles, and further that stoplights, turn signals, and other signaling devices
170 shall be lighted as prescribed for the use of these devices.
