**A RESOLUTION CONCERNING  
MARYLAND NATIONAL GUARD STUDENTS BEING NON DEPLOYABLE**

30 **WHEREAS:** Only a few of Maryland National Guard soldiers are full time college students  
40 and the overwhelming rest of the force are not college students; and,

50 **WHEREAS:** The Maryland national guard insists on college students stopping school  
60 when their units are activated for no less than two years; and,

70 **WHEREAS:** This stoppage makes a Maryland National Guard student's college career nearly  
80 impossible to complete; and,

90 **WHEREAS:** The state of Maryland exempts National Guard students who participate in  
100 ROTC from being activated and deployed to war; and.

110 **WHEREAS:** This exemption should be applied to all students in National Guard and not just  
120 those participating in ROTC.

140 **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:** That the Maryland Student Legislature urges the Maryland  
General Assembly to pass and Governor O'Malley to sign comprehensive legislation making all  
Maryland National Guard members non deployable while in school full time as students.
